THE MINISTRY OF LEADERSHIP

Leaders are called to serve others.

Every organization needs leaders. Leaders in the Church include the hierarchy – the pope and bishops and priests. There are also other positions of leadership in the Church, especially on the parish and diocesan level.

Good leaders seek to serve, enabling the members to reach their common goal. Not every leader is a good leader. Some leaders seek their own self-interest at the expense of those they are supposed to serve. The first reading points out that this can be true in the Church as well as in the world. Jesus is the ideal leader. His concern is the good of others. Even when our leaders fail us, we know that God continues to care for God's people.

National Catechetical Directory

...in a special way bishops, priests, and deacons are called – and through ordination empowered – to minister in Christ's name and that of the Church. They do this by proclaiming the word, embodying the gospel in the community of believers, leading the community in worship, healing its divisions, and summoning its members to reconciliation. (#133, see also #s 66, 69, 93)

Catechism of the Catholic Church

The Good Shepherd ought to be the model and "form" of the bishop's pastoral office. Conscious of his own weaknesses, "the bishop...can have compassion for those who are ignorant and erring. He should not refuse to listen to his subjects whose welfare he promotes as of his very own children....The faithful...should be closely attached to the bishop as the Church is to Jesus Christ and as Jesus Christ is to the Father":

Let all follow the bishop, as Jesus Christ follows his Father, and the college of presbyters as the apostles; respect the deacons as you do God's law. Let no one do anything concerning the Church in separation from the bishop. (#896)

Families in need of decent housing and whose yearly income falls within the guidelines may apply. The guidelines are between \$10,025 and \$24,100 for one person up to \$18,900 and \$45,400 for an eight person family. The Family Selection Committee will choose homeowners based on: 1) level of need, 2) willingness to become partners in the program, and 3) ability to repay the non-interest loan. A non-discriminatory policy is followed in selecting partner families. Neither race nor religion is a factor in choosing a family to receive a Habitat house.
