Sunday, September 27

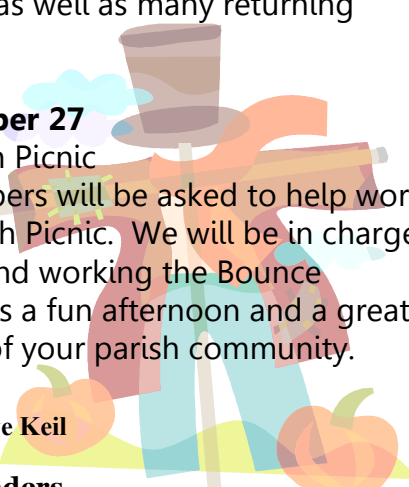
St. Nicholas Parish Picnic
